ABOUT DHHL

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands carries out Prince Jonah Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole's vision of rehabilitating native Hawaiians by returning them to the land. Established by U.S. Congress in 1921 with the passage of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, the Hawaiian homesteading program run by DHHL includes management of more than 200,000 acres of land statewide with the specific purpose of developing and delivering homesteading.

Our partnership with the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) began in 2008 with the awarding of Kānehili. Since then, Gentry Homes has built over 500 homes for Hawaiian families. Each home built offers the latest in design and technology. Gentry's energy saving features ensure comfort and efficiency while reducing our carbon footprint.





built Gentry Homes has 14,000 new homes in Hawai'i continues to integrate technology and designs to ensure our customers come home to a sustainable home. Gentry Homes Ltd began building in Hawai'i in 1968 with its first community on the windward side of O'ahu, Ocean View Estates. Several others followed and in 1979 Gentry began work on 510 acres in central O'ahu known as Waipi'o Gentry.



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Ka'uluokaha'i II-C

Increment II-C will provide a total of 115 turnkey homes with four distinct floor plans to choose from. Twelve vacant lots will also be available for owner-builders. These residences will be available to lessees with undivided interests. First families are slated for move in in early-2026.



Submit your Response Form and Pre-Qualification Letter by July 25, 2025.




STEP 2

If eligible, you may be invited to participate in the lot selection meeting on August 23, where you could have the opportunity to select your house and lot.





BECOMING A HOMEOWNER

- Schedule your Sales Contract meeting with Gentry.
- Select your home options and upgrades, then sign the Sales Contract.
- Home construction begins following contract execution.
- Finalize your loan with your selected lender.
- Recordation and Closing Upon completion, you may receive your keys and move in.


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


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
